If your supplier disappears you need, if possible, to be able to tap straight into their sub-suppliers to ensure you can service the link above you in the chain.

Standard terms and conditions of trading rarely incorporate the best provisions for dealing with these situations. The contracts need to reflect the overriding importance of the continuation of supply and the mechanics of recall and product intervention.
